The candidate should register for her/his Quince Años ceremony on or before her/his 14th birthday. The candidate must have been baptized in the Roman Catholic Church and must have received First Eucharist prior to the time of the ceremony. If the honoree has not received the Sacrament of Communion, she/he should be enrolled to prepare to receive the sacrament before the Quince Años ceremony. The candidate must attend and complete preparation sessions with the coordinator and must join our parish youth program. Pick up Quinceañera information check-list.



Fr. Roger's Letter



Dear Friends in St. Dominic

Trinity Sunday is a feast celebrated a week after Pentecost Sunday. This is also known as Holy Trinity Sunday honoring the most fundamental of Christian beliefs—belief in the Holy Trinity. The human mind can never fully understand the mystery of the Trinity, but we can sum it up in the following formula: God is three Persons in one Nature. There is only one God, and the three Persons of God—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—are all equally God, and They cannot be divided.

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is a basic doctrine of faith in Christianity, understandable not with our heads but with our hearts. It teaches us that there are three distinct Persons in one God, sharing the same Divine nature. Here, we are dealing not just with some terribly abstract theological doctrine, still less with a mathematical contradiction that $1+1+1=1$. What Scripture reveals to us is a unity of three real Persons. Of course, to try to understand fully how one God can be three Persons is not really possible for us.

However, while dealing with this, we have to avoid two extreme measures: First, breaking our heads trying to work out fully how one God can be three Persons, and Second, saying---Oh, it is a mystery and not bother to have any understanding at all. On the one hand, we are constituted as human beings to want to understand, to find meaning in things, and we should always try to go as far as we can in making sense of our faith. On the other hand, there are many things in life which are and probably always will be far beyond our understanding. That does not mean we deny their truth or their existence. Even human life itself, even our own lives, our very identity as persons – body, mind & soul is something we never fully grasp. Instead, then, of trying to indulge in theological acrobatics or worrying about orthodox formulations, let us try to enter into a relationship with these three Persons, through whom God is revealed to us.

Today's feast can be a reminder to pray with much greater meaning and respect that most common of all prayers, so common we hardly think of it as a prayer – the Sign of the Cross – IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER, AND OF THE SON AND OF THE HOLY SPIRIT. AMEN. It combines both the mystery of the Trinity and mystery of our salvation through Jesus' suffering, death and rising to life. It encapsulates in so few words and a simple movement of the arm all that we believe in and all that we live for. Let us, then resolve to make this sign with greater dignity and reverence and in a spirit of real prayer. And this is the Good News of today.

Queridos Amigos en San Dominic,

El domingo de la Trinidad es una fiesta que se celebra una semana después del domingo de Pentecostés. Esto también se conoce como Domingo de la Santísima Trinidad que honra la más fundamental de las creencias cristianas-creencia en la Santísima Trinidad. La mente humana nunca puede entender Misterio de la Trinidad, pero podemos resumirlo en la siguiente fórmula: Dios es tres Personas en una Naturaleza. Hay un solo Dios, y las tres Personas de Dios -el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo- todas igualmente Dios, y no pueden ser divididos.

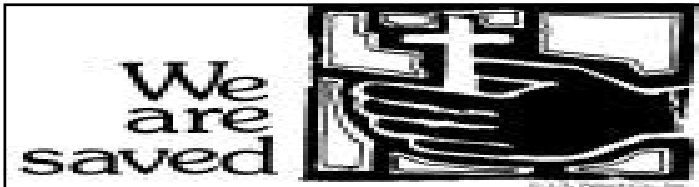
El misterio de la Santísima Trinidad es una doctrina básica de la fe en el cristianismo, comprensible no con nuestras cabezas, sino con nuestros corazones. Nos enseña que hay tres Personas distintas en un solo Dios, compartiendo la misma naturaleza Divina. Aquí, no se trata sólo de una doctrina teológica terriblemente abstracta, y menos aún con una contradicción matemática que $1 + 1 + 1 = 1$. Lo que la Escritura nos revela es una unidad de tres Personas reales. Por supuesto, tratar de comprender plenamente cómo un Dios puede ser tres personas no es realmente posible para nosotros.

Sin embargo, al tratar con esto, tenemos que evitar dos medidas extremas: Primero, rompiendo nuestras cabezas tratando de trabajar plenamente cómo un Dios puede ser tres personas, y Segundo, diciendo ---- Oh, es un misterio y no molestar Para tener cualquier comprensión en absoluto. Por un lado, estamos constituidos como seres humanos para querer entender, para encontrar sentido en las cosas, y siempre debemos intentar ir tan lejos como podamos en el sentido de nuestra fe. Por otro lado, hay muchas cosas en la vida que son y probablemente siempre será mucho más allá de nuestra comprensión. Eso no significa que negamos su verdad o su existencia. Incluso la vida humana en sí, incluso nuestras propias vidas, nuestra propia identidad como personas - cuerpo, mente y alma es algo que nunca captamos completamente. En vez de tratar de acostumbrarse a las acrobacias teológicas o de preocuparse por las formulaciones ortodoxas, intentemos entrar en una relación con estas tres personas, por medio de las cuales Dios nos es revelado.

La fiesta de hoy puede ser un recordatorio para orar con mucho mayor significado y respeto que el más común de todas las oraciones, tan comunes que casi no lo pensamos como una oración - el Signo de la Cruz - EN EL NOMBRE DEL PADRE Y DEL HIJO Y DEL ESPÍRITU SANTO. AMÉN. Combina tanto el misterio de la Trinidad como el misterio de nuestra salvación a través del sufrimiento de Jesús, la muerte y el ascenso a la vida. Encapsula en tan pocas palabras y en un simple movimiento del brazo todo lo que creemos y todo lo que vivimos. Resolvamos, pues, hacer este signo con mayor dignidad y reverencia y con un espíritu de oración real. Y esta es la Buena Nueva de hoy.

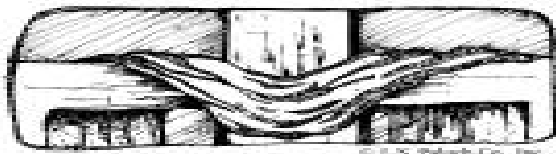

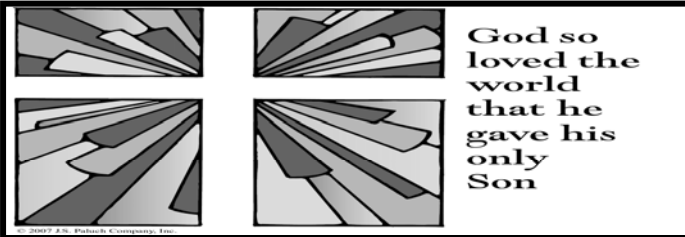

THE INEXPRESSIBLE MYSTERY

The God of the universe is mysterious. Science has not been able to solve the mystery of how the universe came into being or explain exactly what continues to give it creative energy and masterful design. No religion asserts that it has found words to name fully the ineffable mystery of God, for no matter what name we use, God always transcends our limited ability to understand. God is a mystery to be believed, not known. And yet, we Christians believe that our name for God best expresses that inexpressible mystery: God is the Most Holy Trinity of three persons united in a communion of love, pouring forth that creative, saving, sanctifying love into the world. Today's scriptures celebrate the mystery of the Trinity and give us clues for living that mystery in our lives.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

It is often heard that today's observance is an "idea feast," and that it is somewhat difficult to grasp its meaning. Other great solemnities, such as Christmas and Easter, have an easily grasped core. Yet, even though the Trinity is at the heart of our faith, firmly declared in the Creed since the Council of Nicea in 325, we are used to having people shrug and say, "Well, it's a mystery."

Perhaps it is more helpful to think of this as a "relationship feast," since it unveils our deepest identity. Dorothy Day was a great social reformer, pacifist, and ardent lover of the Trinity. When people told her that she would certainly be canonized one day (the process is indeed underway), she protested dismissively by remarking that people were raising a fuss just because she was not afraid to talk about God. She loved the Trinity, and treasured the traditional icon for the feast, also known as "The Hospitality of Abraham," depicting the three angelic beings seated at a table tilted toward the viewer and laden with bread and wine. For her, the Trinity revealed the heart of the Catholic life, three C's if you will: community, communication, and communion. That was not an "idea" for her, but what it means to be created in the image of the Triune God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

MISTERIO INEXPRESABLE

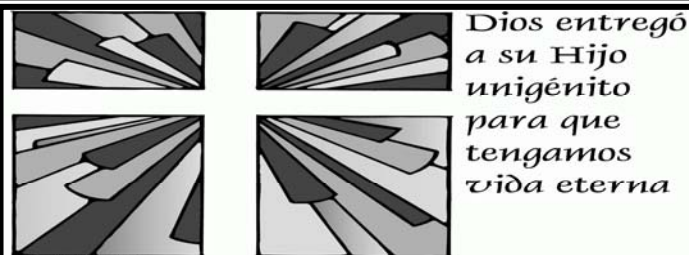

Dios es un misterio en el que se cree y que no se conoce. Y sin embargo, nosotros los cristianos creemos que el nombre que usamos para Dios es el que mejor expresa ese misterio inexpresable: Dios es la Santísima Trinidad de tres personas unidas en una comunión de amor, que se vierte en amor creador, salvador y santificador sobre el mundo. Las lecturas de hoy celebran el misterio de la Trinidad y nos dan las claves para vivir ese misterio en nuestras vidas.

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Toda devoción mariana debe seguir los pasos de Cristo. Y todo lo que decimos acerca de María deberíamos decirlo de nosotros como Iglesia, porque ella es nuestra madre, hermana y modelo. Si Jesús es el Hijo de Dios, María y nosotros también somos hijos e hijas de Dios. Si Jesús tiene un Sagrado Corazón que arde por amor al humano, María tiene un corazón inmaculado que arde con ese mismo amor. ¿Y nosotros?

La devoción al Inmaculado Corazón de María fue promovida por el Papa Pío XII en 1942, durante la Segunda Guerra Mundial. El Papa pidió a María tres gracias para los fieles en Cristo: amor a la pureza, práctica de la vida cristiana y celo apostólico. De esta manera nuestro corazón puede llegar a ser como el de ella.

El corazón inmaculado de María es un corazón que no tiene mancha de pecado. Es un corazón que imita el Sagrado Corazón de su Hijo y Dios, Jesús. Es recuerdo de lo que nuestros corazones pueden ser. Es invitación a que nos vayamos purificando y creciendo en amor ardiente por el prójimo
